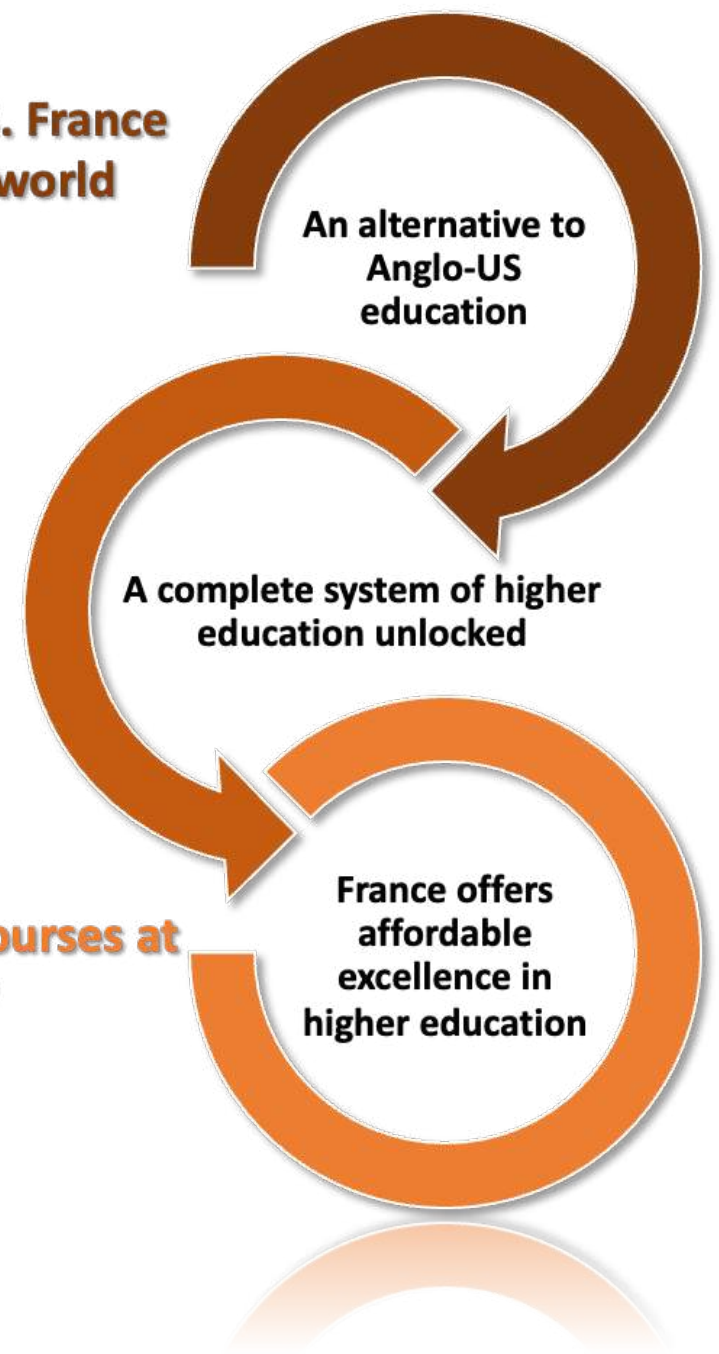

400 000 international students hosted in France in 2023. France is one of the major higher education destination in the world

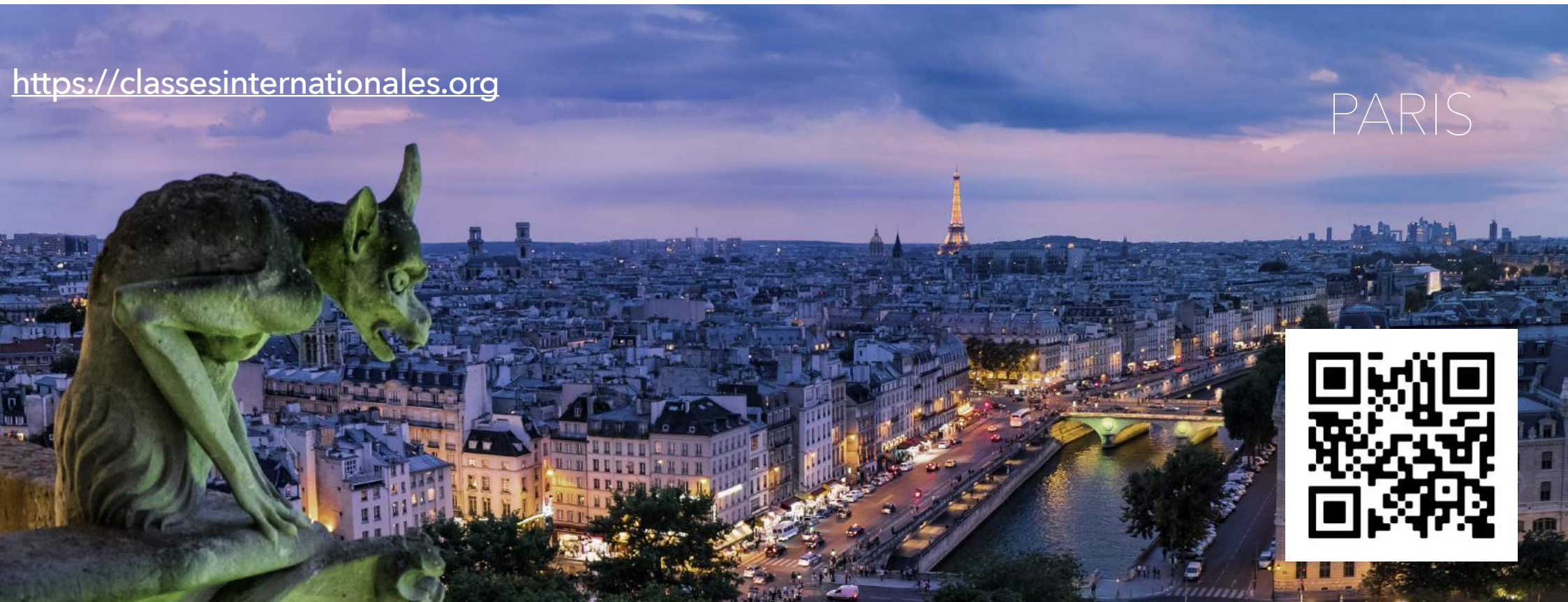
80 public universities, 204 engineering schools, 43 management schools, 3 000 specialised higher education institutions

Many Indian students have taken French language courses at High school. This may be enough skills already to try France as their higher education treasure trove



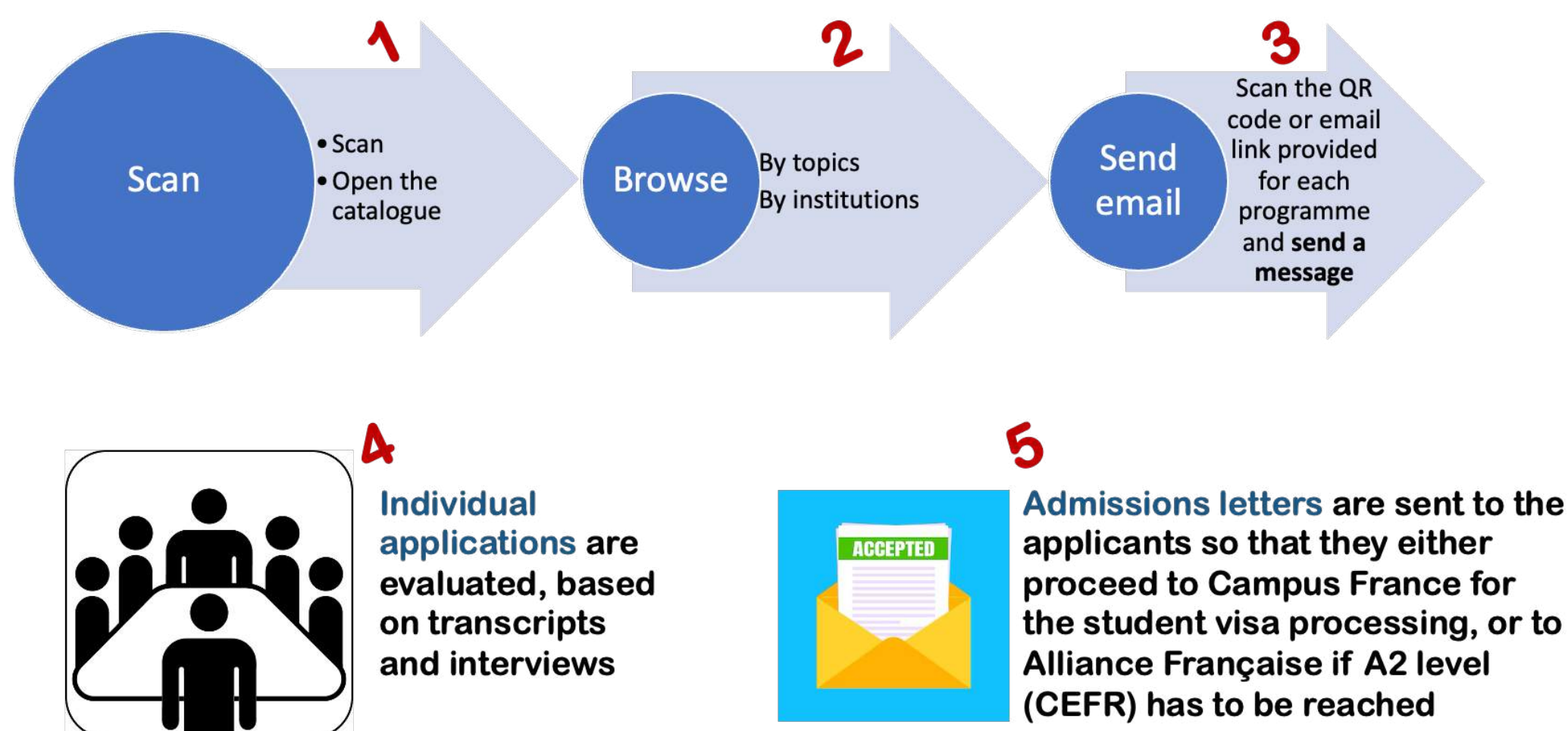

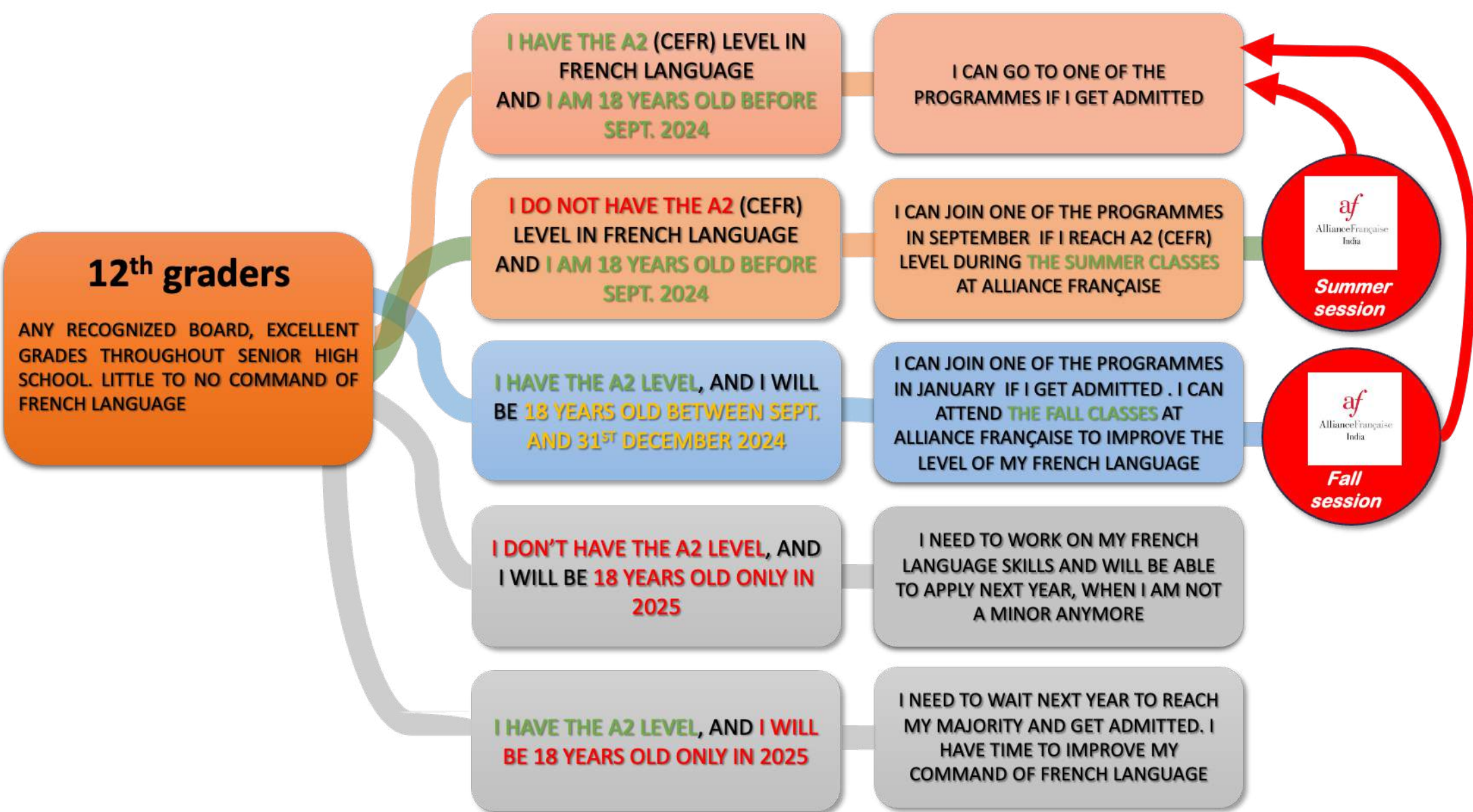

15-25 students for 1 class

Ideal balance for language classes

-2 semesters of 13 weeks

Some universities will schedule the overall teaching load differently, please see the catalogue.

French as a Foreign Language (FFL)

20 hours of FFL per week (i.e. 26 45-minute sessions), comprising 200 hours of general French and 44 hours of thematic courses (French on academic objectives for advanced learners, French on special objective for less experienced learners, or reinforcement of one of the skills).

-a team dedicated to monitoring, supervision and guidance

Academic load

-5 contact hours or lab equivalent / week: Subject 1 (taken from the service of a teacher-researcher)

-5h contact hours or lab equivalent/ week: Subject 2 (taken from the service of a teacher-researcher)

-Optional: 5h TD equivalent / week: Subject 3 (taken from the service of a teacher-researcher)
